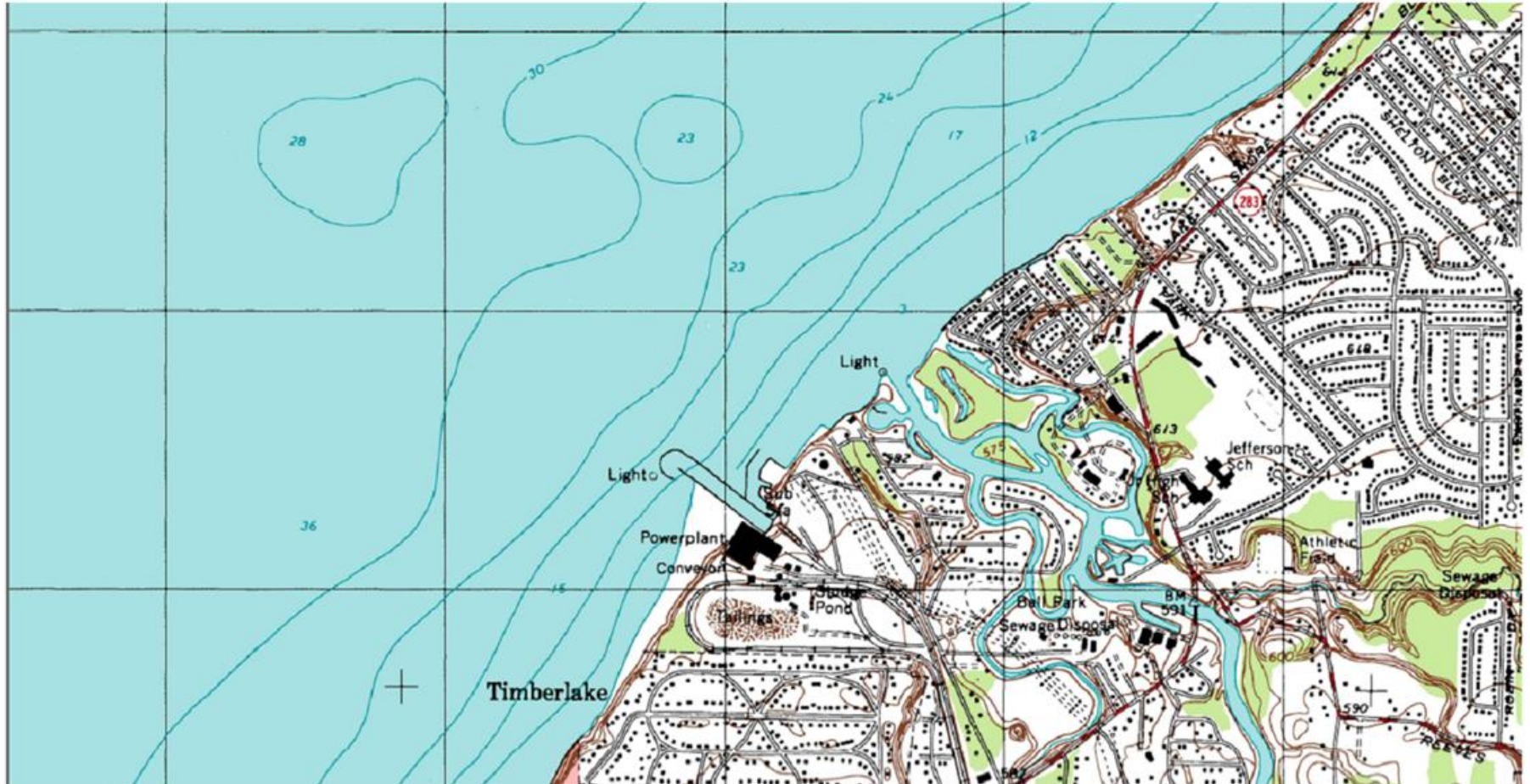



Topographic map of Eastlake, Ohio
