## FISH SCALES AND TALES

- 1** Lake Whitefish can live for 15 to 20 years, while a common carp can live to more than 50 years.
- 2** Suckers swim upstream to spawn in the spring.
- 3** Lake Whitefish eggs sit on the bottom through the winter and then hatch in the early spring.
- 4** The eggs from the Bloater Chub are salted and sent to Europe where they are a delicacy.
- 5** The Yellow Perch typically lives up to 10-11 years in their natural habitat.
