

Did you fish the big lake?

Donate your fish stomachs to the Huron-Michigan Predator Diet Study!

Step 1. Measure fish

- Measure to nearest ½"



Step 2. Remove stomach

- Cut as close to head as possible
- Remove intestines and other organs if possible, but whole entrails are OK!



Step 3. Complete data card for each fish

- Use knife, paperclip, or hole punch to accurately select options, or use pencil to circle (ink bleeds when wet)

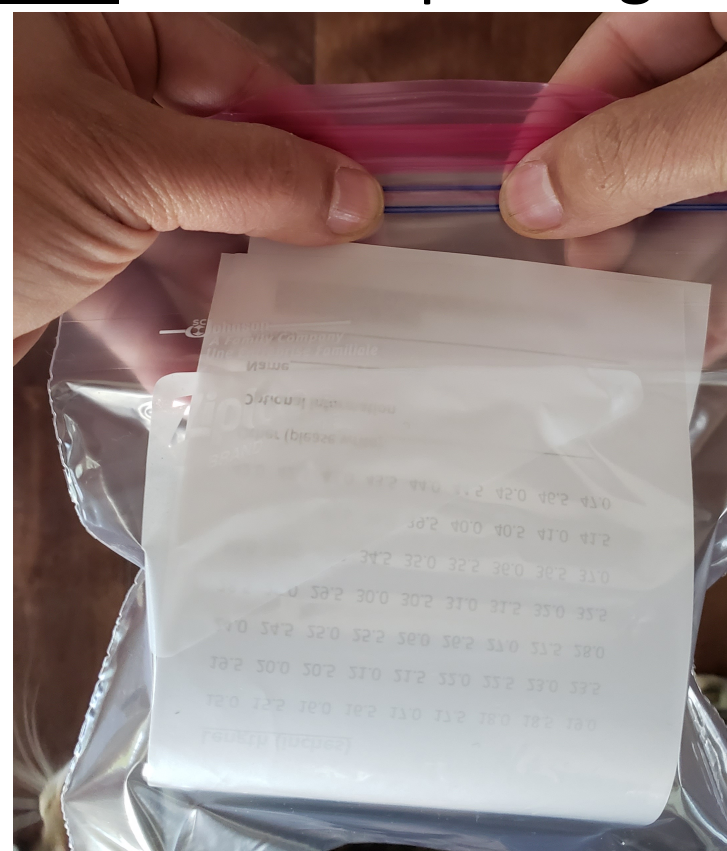
